Project 2 – Charity – Due November 28/December 5

For this project you will need to select a charity that you would like to support financially (with your own money). Some ideas for you to consider are: a church, a missionary family, an organization that feeds the hungry (eg: Winnipeg Harvest, Union Gospel Mission, Mennonite Central Committee), an organization that helps the sick (eg: Heart and Stroke Foundation, Kidney Foundation), an organization that helps children (eg: Compassion, World Vision, Samaritans Purse Christmas Shoe Boxes).

Once you have selected a charity you would like to support you will need to decide how much money you want to give and how you will get it. You can give money you have from your piggy bank, your allowance, you can find ways to work and earn money to give; the choice is yours (the only rule is that it needs to be your money).

Finally, you need to send the money to the charity.
