- 1. If a boy is disobeying the rules, being disrespectful to the leaders, behaving in such a manner that is creating an unsafe environment or is being generally disruptive he will be sent to see the Club Leader to discuss the incident. Depending on the nature of the incident, the boy may be required to miss the remainder of the activity.
- 2. If a boy continues to misbehave after an initial incident, a parent/guardian will be called, and the boy will be sent home. If a parent/guardian cannot be reached, the boy will stay at club until 8:30 pm and will not be able to come back to club until we have discussed the problem with the parents/guardian.
- 3. If the boy has been sent home (or a call has been made to parent/guardian) twice, he will not be allowed to come back to club until after the Christmas break, or for the remainder of club year if after Christmas. A plan to reintegrate the boy may be discussed between the parents/guardian and the Boy's Club Leader.
