

What seeds are you planting? Prairie Rose EMC, May 16, 2021 Pastor Mike – Mark 4:26-29



²⁶ He also said, "This is what the kingdom of God is like. A man scatters seed on the ground. ²⁷ Night and day, whether he sleeps or gets up, the seed sprouts and grows, though he does not know how. ²⁸ All by itself the soil produces grain—first the stalk, then the head, then the full kernel in the head. ²⁹ As soon as the grain is ripe, he puts the sickle to it, because the harvest has come." Mark 4:26-29

Observations:

#1 God expects growth.

#2 Fruit in my life comes from seeds planted by someone.

#3 We often can't see the seeds that are growing in our lives.

#4 Growth in my life is slow, and gradual,

and it happens in stages.

Principles of spiritual growth:

- 1. Everything starts as a seed. (Gen. 1:11)
- 2. A seed has no power until it's planted. (John 12:24-25)
- 3. Whatever I plant is what I'll harvest.

(Gal. 6:7; Prov. 11:18; 22:8; Hosea 10:12)

- 4. I'm not the only one planting seeds in my life. (John 4:38)
- 5. I harvest in a different season than I plant. (Eccl. 3:1-5)
- 6. I always harvest more than I plant. (Mark 4:8)
- 7. I should always be planting seeds. (Eccl. 11:4)
- 8. While I'm waiting for the harvest,
 I must be patient and not give up. (Gal. 6:9)
